He started his career writing poetry and criticism, publishing in several Roumanian journals, he was born in Romania to a French mother and Romanian father and spent majority of his life in France

Ionesco wrote his first play in 1948; he was 39yrs old then.

Exit the King is unusual among Ionesco's works in that the plot is linear and focuses on depletion rather than accumulation.
